Item 3: To receive, approve and adopt:

3.1 Annual Report for the calendar year ending 2020 and Audited Statement of Accounts for the financial year 2019-20.

Annual Report for the calendar year ending 2020 and Audited Statement of Accounts for the financial year 2019-20 is enclosed as **Annexure – I** for favour of consideration.

3.2 Budget Estimates for the financial year 2021-22.

The Budge Estimate for the financial year 2021-22 were placed before the Executive Council in its 116th Meeting held on 29-12-2020, which was discussed in detailed and approved by the Council.

The General Body may approve the decision of the Executive Council. The Budget Estimates for the financial year 2021-22 is enclosed as **Annexure – II.**

3.3 Appointment of Auditors for the financial year 2021-22.

Hon. President, ISTE informed the Executive Council in its 116th Meeting and the past performance of Auditor's M/s H.C. Agarwal & Associates, is satisfactory. Based on their past performance the Council resolved to continue the same auditor for the year 2021-2022.

The General Body may approve the decision of the Executive Council.

Item 4: 50th ISTE National Annual Faculty Convention and 23rd National Students Convention of ISTE.

Due to the present pandemic situation of Covid-19, the National Annual Faculty Convention and National Students Convention of ISTE was not conducted during the year 2020 and it is practically seems to be impossible to conduct both Conventions in physical mode at the present situation.

The issue was discussed in the EC Meetings and Hon. President, ISTE appealed EC to give their suggestions so that the strategy can be decided. Considering the situation, finally it was resolved that both Annual Faculty and Annual Student Convention for the 2020 will be conducted during the next year 2021 depending upon the prevailing situation at that time.

However, considering the present situation it is not possible to conduct it in physical mode. Hence, it is proposed to conduct both the conventions on virtual mode.

The General Body may decide the appropriate decision about conduct of conventions on virtual mode.

Item 5: To inform the following:

i. AICTE-ISTE Orientation/Refresher Programs 2021-22

The new proposals were invited for the AICTE-ISTE Orientation/Refresher Programs 2021-22 under the AQIS scheme of AICTE through Online. The last date for receiving the proposals was February, 2021. Process of finalizing the programs is under progress and the same will be announced in due course.

ii. Skill Development Training Programs for Students in collaboration with BNY Mellon Technology (India) Pvt. Ltd.

ISTE & BNY Mellon signed MoU for the Skill Development Training Program for faculties and it is expected that they will train the students from their institute. The first initiative of this venture was training program on **Artificial Intelligence** and **Machine Learning** for faculties and students of Engineering & Polytechnic Colleges in India.

The training of the first batch is completed and the work for 2nd batch in **Artificial Intelligence and Machine Learning** and **IoT** is under progress.

iii. About the completion of ISTE Building work.

ISTE Extension Building project was a dream project for ISTE since 2001. The work awarded to M/s S.N.S. Infra Projects Pvt. Ltd., New Delhi. The inaugural ceremony of the laying foundation stone of ISTE Building Extension, Solar Roof Top Plant and Dr. A.P.J. Abdul Kalam Meeting Hall was conducted on 27th September, 2017 at ISTE Hqrs., New Delhi by the hands of Dr. Anil D. Sahasrabudhe, Chairman, All India Council for Technical Education, New Delhi; Dr. N.R. Shetty, Chancellor of Central University of Karnataka, Kalaburagi and Dr. R.S. Nirjar, Former Vice Chancellor, Gautam Budha University, Greater Noida respectively.

Now, the ISTE Extension Building project is completed in all respect and ISTE has received Completion-cum Occupancy Certificate from South Delhi Municipal Corporation.

iv. Enrolment of Corporate Institutional Membership

As per existing norms, ISTE grant institutional membership to recognized institutions only to following categories under clause 2 (v).

- Institutions approved by AICTE offering technical education in engineering & technology & polytechnics offering diploma in engineering & technology.
- Universities & their departments, colleges offering courses in engineering & technology, Arch, Town Planning, Pharmacy, Management, HMCT etc.
- Recognised research institute in engineering & technology.


- Central & State Government Dept. having active interest in Technical Education.
- Industrial & Professional Organisation in India & Abroad having active interest in technical education in India.

Lot of Corporate companies like, TCS, Wipro, Sapient, Cognizent, Infosys, HCL, KPMG etc. have worked with ISTE in the past and shown interest in various technical activities. Though these corporate companies are not out institutional members but shown active interest in various technical activities and sought permission for use of ISTE Logo and its technical collaboration.

It is proposed to allow them to become Institutional Member for conducting any event in association with ISTE and to use Logo for their seminar/ workshop/conference etc. Hence it is proposed to introduce **Corporate Institutional Membership** under Industrial and Professional Organisation category.

The matter was placed before the EC in its 116th Meeting and the council discussed in detailed and suggested that corporate membership should be encouraged and finally decided that Membership committee will look into the criteria and fee for the corporate membership and will give appropriate recommendations. The recommendation of the committee will put before the next Executive Council for approval. This will help to develop better Industry-Academia relations.
